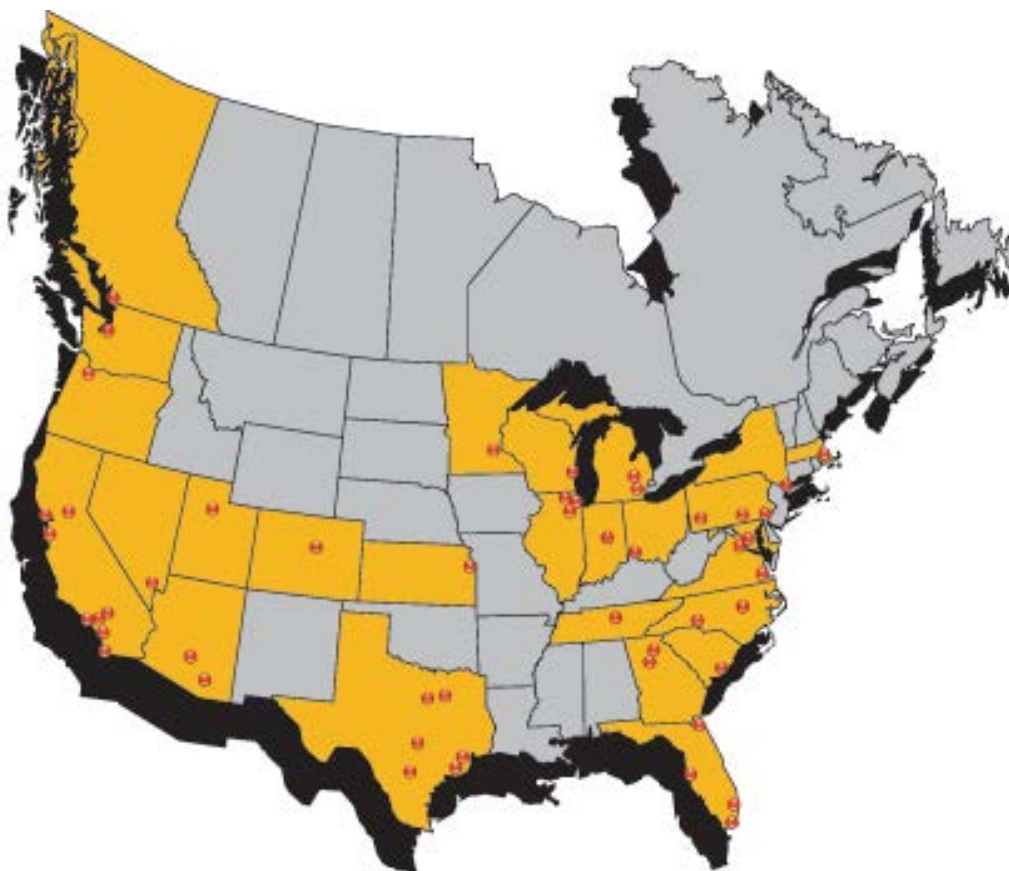

QUALITY What We Do

EDMC has four primary education institutions that offer a broad range of academic programs concentrated in the creative and applied arts, behavioral sciences, education, health sciences and business fields, culminating in the award of associate through doctoral degrees, as well as non-degree programs. In addition, Western State University College of Law offers the *juris doctorate* degree:

- **Argosy University** (www.argosy.edu), with 19 campus locations in 13 states, provides undergraduate and graduate degrees to students in an environment where academic knowledge is paired with interpersonal skills vital to success in an increasingly competitive market. Argosy University has five colleges: Psychology and Behavioral Sciences, Business, Education, Health Sciences and Undergraduate Studies.
- **The Art Institutes** (www.artinstitutes.edu) is a system of 50 education institutions located throughout North America. The Art Institutes schools provide an important source for design, media arts, fashion and culinary arts professionals. Several institutions included in The Art Institutes system are campuses of South University.
- **Brown Mackie College** (www.brownmackie.edu), with 27 schools located throughout the United States, offers educational programs that prepare students for entry-level positions in a rapidly-changing workplace. Brown Mackie College schools offer bachelor's degree, associate degree, certificate and diploma programs in health sciences, business, information technology, legal studies and design technologies.
