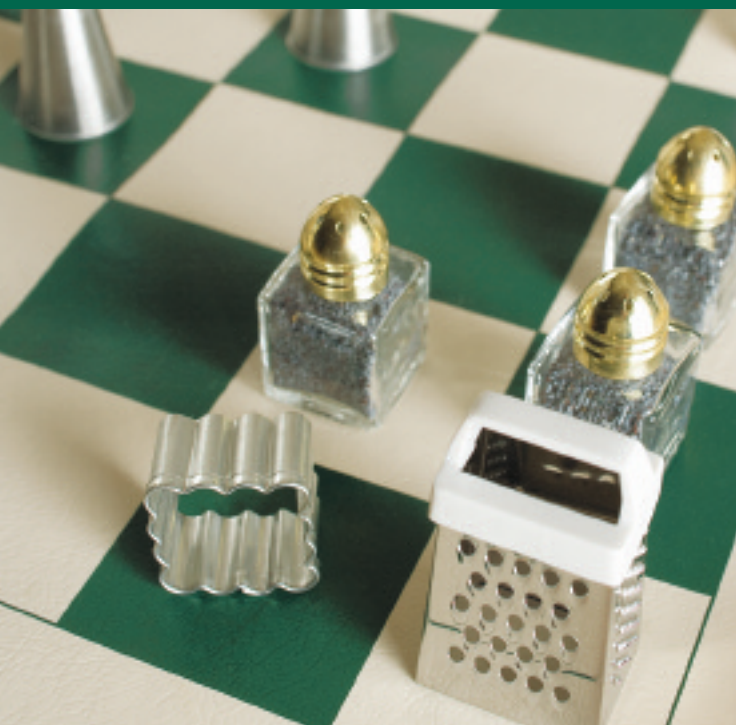

Getting Started

Competition Eligibility

- Competition open to graduating high school seniors with a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average.
- Submit an entry form to a school of The Art Institutes that offers a Culinary Arts program. This school will be the location you represent in the competition and plan to attend following the competition.
- You must fulfill all individual culinary program admission requirements of The Art Institute you wish to attend.

Deadline

Entries must be received by **February 9, 2007**.

How to Enter

Complete the attached entry form and mail it with your entry requirement materials (listed below) to The Art Institute location you wish to represent.

Entry Requirements

Please submit the following to enter the Best Teen Chef competition:

- Completed entry form
- Copy of your high school transcript
- An essay (minimum 250 words) that addresses why you'd like to be a culinary professional, who inspires you, and the reason you'd like to attend The Art Institute where you're entering the competition.
- A notebook that includes a menu with descriptions for a two-course meal – including appetizer, soup or salad, and a main course with sauce, garnish, vegetable, and starch. Please include detailed recipes and directions for each course. Also include an image of each course and an image that includes all courses.

Based on entry information and materials, a select number of winners will be chosen to advance to the local cook-off competition.

Local Competitions

Approximately 10 semi-finalists from each participating Art Institute will be chosen to compete in local cook-offs on March 17, 2007. Contestants will prepare a menu issued in advance by The Art Institutes and have their work judged by a panel of professional chefs and culinary faculty.

The first-place winner from each participating local cook-off will advance to The Art Institutes Best Teen Chef Culinary Scholarship Competition finals.

All decisions by the judges are final and non-disputable.



The Art Institutes Best Teen Chef Culinary Scholarship Competition

The first place winner from each participating school will be flown along with one parent or legal guardian to Dallas, TX for a reception at The Art Institute of Dallas on May 4, 2007 and The Art Institutes Best Teen Chef cook-off on May 5, 2007. At the competition, contestants prepare a menu issued in advance by The Art Institutes. A panel of professional chefs and certified master chefs will serve as judges. All decisions made by the judges are final and non-disputable.

The first, second, and third place winners each will be awarded a full-tuition scholarship at The Art Institute they've chosen to represent. The fourth, fifth, and sixth place winners each will be awarded a half-tuition scholarship to The Art Institute they plan to attend after the competition. The seventh, eighth, and ninth place winners each will be awarded a quarter-tuition scholarship to The Art Institute they're representing. Each remaining national candidate not in the top nine will be awarded a \$2,000 tuition scholarship.

All tuition scholarships are awarded toward a culinary associate's degree, diploma, or certificate program. The tuition scholarship award received may also be used as a partial credit toward a culinary bachelor's degree program, should one be offered at the winner's represented school and the applicant meets admission requirements into the program. Should a winner choose to exercise this option, the credit toward a bachelor's degree program will equal the tuition scholarship amount awarded toward the culinary associate's or certificate program at the school.

All tuition scholarships must be used at The Art Institute location you've chosen to represent. Scholarships are non-transferable, and upon accepting the scholarship, you must begin your culinary arts studies in the summer or fall immediately following the national cook-off.
