SCHOOL-SPONSORED (S-S) HOUSING

SCHOOL SPONSORED HOUSING (S-S Housing)

Ai Dallas contracts with a local apartment community to provide housing to students who wish to live in an environment with other Ai Dallas students. The Housing Program places students according to their likes/dislikes, study habits, academic level, and program. **NOTE: Each student who applies for School-Sponsored Housing must sign a RELEASE form in order for the apartment community to perform a background check. Students who fail to sign this release will not be placed in housing.**

There are four options for S-S Housing:

Option 1: 1 Bedroom/1-Bath (1 student)

Option 2: 1-Bedroom/1-bath (2 students)

Option 3: 2-bedroom/2-bath (up to 4 students)

Option 4: 2-bedroom/2-bath (2 students)

Housing costs cover rent, utilities, and furniture for each unit (Options 1 and 4 include a queen size bed). Students may bring TVs, VCRs, DVD players, computers, microwaves, etc. Students will be responsible for their own phone, internet, and cable bills. All units have washer/dryer hookups. Ai Dallas **does not** supply washers and dryers, but you will have the option to lease them for \$40 per month- This cost is not covered in your financial plan.

COST FOR S-S HOUSING

Students are required to pay housing costs and a housing placement deposit. The cost for housing is figured into your overall financial plan, which allows you to make ONE payment to the school. **S-S Housing students are required to sign a FOUR (4) quarter contract.** In the event a student drops S-S Housing, they will be assessed the following penalties: Current months housing cost plus two additional months housing costs.

REQUIREMENTS FOR S-S HOUSING

To be placed in S-S Housing, students are required to do the following:

The placement deposit and the housing forms must be submitted by the applicable deadline in order to secure housing.

NEED A ROOMMATE?

Students that live independently often need another individual to help share expenses. The Housing Program will help facilitate roommate connections. The student must fill out a Roommate Questionnaire and submit it to the Assistant Director of Residence Life and Housing. There are no guarantees; however, the department will work to accommodate roommate needs.

SCHOOL-SPONSORED (S-S) HOUSING OPTIONS **INFORMATION PAGE**

Residence Life and Housing at The Art Institute of Dallas is continually trying to find ways to improve the quality of life for our housing students. **There are 4 options.** These options give students placed in S-S housing the opportunity to decide what the best housing plan is for them.

Please inform your Financial Planner of which option you prefer in order to avoid having to revise your financial plan.

OPTION 1 – *Very Limited*

Single – 1 Bedroom/1 Bath Unit - student - includes rent, utilities, and furniture

Unit has a queen-size bed

COST: \$2,811/per quarter HOUSING PLACEMENT DEPOSIT: \$250 (*Costs are subject to change*)

OPTION 2

Double - 1 Bedroom/1 Bath Unit - 2 students - includes rent, utilities, and furniture

Students will share all areas of the unit

COST: \$2,221 per quarter HOUSING PLACEMENT DEPOSIT: \$250 (*Costs are subject to change*)

OPTION 3

2 Bedroom / 2 Bath Unit - 4 students - includes rent, utilities, and furniture

Each student shares a bedroom and bathroom with one other student and all the common areas of the unit with all students

COST: \$1,798 per quarter HOUSING PLACEMENT DEPOSIT: \$250 (*Costs are subject to change*)

OPTION 4

2 Bedroom / 2 Bath Unit - 2 students - includes rent, utilities, and furniture

Each student has their own bedroom and bathroom, but shares the rest of the apartment with one other student

COST: \$2,731 per quarter HOUSING PLACEMENT DEPOSIT: \$250 (*Costs are subject to change*)

BACKGROUND CHECKS

Ai Dallas provides housing for students through a contract with a local apartment community; therefore we must adhere to the policies set forth by the apartment community. It is a requirement that a **BACKGROUND CHECK** be performed on all residents living at the apartment property. Ai Dallas does not administer the Background Check. It is processed by the apartment community where School-Sponsored Housing is located.

The enclosed **RELEASE** form must be signed and returned along with your housing application, roommate questionnaire, and placement deposit in order for you to be considered for placement in School-Sponsored Housing.

The **BACKGROUND CHECK** will consist of a *criminal record check*. The list below contains items that will exclude you from being placed in housing. If you are aware of one or more of these items being on your record, it may be beneficial to explore other housing options with the Assistant Director of Residence Life and Housing. **The apartment community will not make exceptions concerning these particular items.**

- **Persons possessing any felony indictments or convictions**
- **Persons possessing more than one (1) class A or B misdemeanor, either indictment or conviction**
- **Persons with a misdemeanor for drug possession or drug possession with intent to sell, prostitution, burglary, sex offenses, or crimes against persons**

Please complete and sign the enclosed RELEASE form and return it to Ai Dallas Housing Department. Your Background Check **will not** be processed until Ai Dallas Housing Department receives your housing paperwork and placement deposit. Do not delay in getting your paperwork in. All applications should be received at least two (2) weeks prior to class start.

DIRECTIONS from Ai Dallas Parking Garage:

Go RIGHT on Park Lane - Go to the light at Greenville Ave - Turn LEFT on Greenville Ave - Take Greenville to the light at Markville Drive - Turn LEFT and *THE FALLS at HIGHPOINT in on the left.*

WHAT TO BRING

- Food items, Microwave Oven/Toaster/Coffee Pot
- Linens (towels, regular TWIN sheets for Options 2 and 3/regular QUEEN sheets for Options 1 and 4)
- Kitchen Utensils (pots/pans, dishes, flatware, glasses, etc.)
- Bathroom Items (toiletries/shower curtain/rugs etc.)
- Television/VCR/DVD, Stereo/Radio/Alarm Clock, Personal Computer (optional)
- Cleaning Supplies/Vacuum

Please Note: The housing units have limited space. Therefore, it is important to be conservative with the amount of items that you bring.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Large Speakers, Drums/Other Loud Instruments (electric guitars/amps, etc.)
- Candles, Kerosene Lamps, Incense, & any other flammable products - DUE TO FIRE SAFETY POLICY, STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO HAVE THESE ITEMS INSIDE THE HOUSING UNITS! A \$200 FINE IS ASSESSED FOR VIOLATING THIS POLICY!
- Pets of any kind
- Excessive Amount of Belongings
- Alcohol/Drugs/Weapons

JUST A REMINDER: S-S Housing is ALCOHOL & DRUG FREE. Possession of either one in the apartment OR on the premises (the entire apartment community is considered school property) may be grounds for immediate dismissal.

TELEPHONES/COMPUTERS

You can set up a phone line in your apartment; however, it is sometimes difficult to regulate when having roommates.

It is suggested that you set up a local phone line (no long distance) and use a calling card. For Internet service, you will need to set up a separate phone line. The apartments are DSL compatible.

FURNITURE

Students are not allowed to bring any extra furniture without prior approval from the Director of Residence Life and Housing. Ai Dallas provides all furniture necessary for apartment living. Student Desks are currently not available; therefore, if you wish to bring a SMALL desk for computer equipment, please notify the Housing Office.

MOVING FROM ONE UNIT TO ANOTHER

During your placement in housing, it is possible you will be asked to move from one housing unit to another, for the purpose of consolidating students. Keep this in mind when you are planning for "What to Bring".
