About The Art Institute of Colorado

- The Art Institute of Colorado is one of The Art Institutes (www.artinstitutes.edu), a system of more than 45 education institutions located throughout North America.
- The Art Institutes provide programs in design, media arts, fashion and culinary arts.
- The Art Institute of Colorado was founded in 1952 and consists of approximately 100,000 square feet of classroom, computer lab, library, and office space.
- Classes are taught from three locations:
- 1200 Lincoln Street, Denver, CO 80203 with 100,000 square feet which includes 26 classrooms, 15 computer labs, library, digital and traditional photography studios, digital video, animation, sound and editing studios, office space, gallery and parking garage with 246 spaces in the Golden Triangle District in Downtown Denver.
- Industrial Design program is taught at 300 East 9th Avenue, Denver, CO 80203 with a shop, 6 classrooms and one computer lab.
- The International Culinary School at The Art Institute of Colorado is located at 675 S. Broadway, Denver, CO 80203 in the Denver Design Center with four labs for production of hot and cold foods, one baking and pastry lab, one multipurpose lab, and one computer lab along with The Art Institute of Colorado's Assignments Restaurant.
- The library has an extensive collection of over 35,000 separately cataloged items including 20,000 unique titles, video tapes, DVDs, slides and over 200 periodicals. There is seating for 120 patrons.
- The John Jellico Gallery, named after the founder of The Art Institute of Colorado, is 865 square feet and offers over 10 shows per year including the First Congressional District Art Show (sponsored by the Honorable Diana DeGette), local artists and photographers, various student/faculty shows and local artists.
- Student housing, available for up to 300 students, is located at The Towers, 5785 E 8th Avenue, Denver, CO, 80220-4577.
- Assignments Restaurant is located at 675 S. Broadway, Denver, CO 80203 in the Denver Design Center and is operated entirely by students. It is open to the public, Wednesdays through Friday, for lunch and dinner: lunch is served from 11:30 am to 1:30 pm and dinner is served from 6:00 to 8:00 pm. For reservations call 303.778.6625.
- The Art Institute of Colorado donates a variety of creative services and support to local non-profit organizations. Current projects include: Up With People, Denver Children's Advocacy Center, Namlo International, Rocky Mountain Youth Clinic, Colorado State Capitol, Renewable Energy Demonstration Center, Kids First!, Denver Public Schools, Colorado Coalition for the Homeless and Cherry Creek Arts Festival.
- The Art Institute of Colorado has an enrollment of more than 2,120 students as of October 2011.
