WGSN: A news and information service for the fashion industries. It currently offers over 300,000 pages of comprehensive international style information. To get a subscription see the librarian on the 10th floor to get an access code.

Doneger's (formerly Here and There): This online forecasting site features digital versions of our print books with additional features including the latest runways trend information as well as retail, street and runway reports.

Stylesight: This forecasting service delivers concise forecasting and reporting relevant to industry timelines. It includes in-depth universal megacolors and megatrends which forecasts the upcoming season's color and trend direction. It also has a searchable image database with over two million images.

Corbis Education: Corbis is a creative resource for aspiring advertising, marketing and media professionals. It features over 60,000 high-res images. Images can be used for class assignments.

Getty Images: An image database with over 500,000 high-resolution images. Images can be used for class assignments with signature of "I-Promise" form. (Username and password provided by the librarian).

Proquest: Provides access to millions of full text articles from thousands of scholarly journals. It also provides access to over 400 full text U.S., Canadian and international newspapers, nearly 30,000 full text dissertations in the areas of business, psychology, physical sciences, education and more, as well as concise business information from nearly 9,000 market reports.

Wilson Full Text Select: Wilson is a multi-disciplinary 100% full-text database providing full text articles. It includes "Art Gallery Special Collection" an image database featuring medium-resolution classic painting for use in teaching and classroom assignments.

Omni Music: A production music and special effects library for use with filmmaking and other media projects.

Oxford Art Online (formerly Grove Art Online): This resource provides web access to the entire text of the Dictionary of Art (Grove 1996, 34 vols) with annual additions of new material and updates to the text, plus extensive image links and a sophisticated search engine to its entries.

Oxford Reference Online: Oxford Reference Online brings together language and subject reference publishers into a single cross-searchable resource with an expanding range of key titles from the acclaimed *Oxford Series*.

Safari Tech Books Online: Provides over 4500 technical eBook at your control.
