COMMUNITY & RESIDENTIAL LIFE

At The Art Institute of California — San Francisco, residential life is a unique experience. You will have the opportunity to live and learn with other students who share your same interest in the arts. Our dedicated staff hosts social and educational programs that provide you with an instant connection to the school and your community. Our program offers students the opportunity to get involved in school as well as network in the city.

THE LOCATION

The Fillmore Center is located in the heart of San Francisco, a short distance from campus, approximately 15-20 minutes away. Students can walk or choose to take a number of bus routes leading to school.

San Francisco has a number of public transportation options available for commuting to and from school and getting around the city. Parking is limited but available on city streets or for a monthly cost paid directly to the complex (parking fees are not included in the cost of housing). The area surrounding The Fillmore Center offers a number of options for shopping, restaurants, grocery stores, and other convenient resources. AMENITIES

Two-bedroom (4 occupants) and three-bedroom units (6 occupants) are available at The Fillmore Center. All apartments are furnished with twin beds, desks and chairs, dresser(s), kitchen table with chairs, and lamps. The apartments have a full kitchen and one or two bathrooms per unit. Although the student-occupied apartments are within the same complex, neighbors may be non-students.
