

What should I bring? What is already there?

Provided-

Furniture:

The following items will be in each apartment prior to move-in:

- Twin Bed (standard)
- Chest of drawers
- Nightstand
- Desk with chair
- Kitchen table with four chairs
- Sofa
- Side chair
- End table
- Bookcase
- Coffee table

Kitchen Appliances:

- Refrigerator
- Stove
- Dishwasher

What to bring:

- Food items
- Microwave oven
- Linens (towels, standard twin sheets, blanket, bedspread, pillows, mattress pad)
- Kitchen items (pots/pans, dishes, flatware, glasses, can opener, toaster, coffee maker, waste basket, trash bags)
- Bathroom items (toiletries, rugs)
- Lamp for Bedroom and Living room
- Television/VCR/DVD/Cable Cord
- Ethernet Cord or Network Cable for Computer
- Stereo/radio/alarm clock
- Cleaning supplies
- Paper supplies
- Hangers

* *These items are in addition to clothes and any school supplies.*

** *PLEASE NOTE: The housing units have limited space therefore, it is important to be conservative with the amount of items you bring. Keep this in mind when you are planning for "what to bring".*

What NOT to bring:

- Drum sets or other loud instruments (large amps)
- Grills
- Large speakers
- Pets of **any** kind
- Excessive amounts of belongings
- Alcohol/Drugs/Weapons (this includes empty alcohol bottles, paraphernalia, knives, decorative/historical swords, pellet guns, etc.)
- Air conditioners
- Waterbeds
- Pools or lawn decorations
- Candles/incense

Be reminded that the School Sponsored Housing facility is alcohol and drug free. Possession of either one in the apartments may be grounds for immediate removal.
