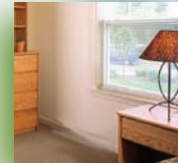


## WHAT'S PROVIDED?

The following items will be in each apartment prior to move-in:

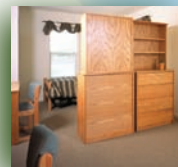
### Furniture:

- Twin Bed
- Chest of Drawers

- Sofa
- Side Chair
- End Table
- Coffee Table



### Appliances:

- Refrigerator
- Stove
- Dishwasher
- Full size Washer & Dryer



## WHAT TO BRING:

- Food Items
- Microwave Oven
- Linens (towels, standard twin sheets, blankets, bed spread, pillows, mattress pad)
- Kitchen Items (pots/pans, dishes, flatware, glasses, can opener, toaster, coffee maker, waste basket, trash bags)
- Bathroom Items (toiletries, rugs)
- Lamp for bedroom
- Television/VCR/DVD/Cable Cord
- Ethernet Cord or Network Cable for Computer
- Stereo/ Radio/ Alarm Clock
- Cleaning supplies
- Hangers

*\* these items are in addition to clothes and any school supplies.*

## Community

- Each unit houses only Art Institute students who share your creative interests
- On-site Resident Assistants and professional staff available to provide advice and guidance

## Convenience and Comfort

- Live within easy walking distance of the school
- Enjoy fully furnished apartments

## Cost

- Pay just one quarterly fee- all utilities\* and furniture included
- Enjoy competitive market rates without the burden of large security deposits and credit checks
- If you are eligible, you can include the cost of housing in your financial aid package
- Lease expires when you graduate

\*\$180 utility allowance per unit per month in the quarterly fee

## Co-curricular Benefits of Living in School Sponsored Housing:

- Living in school sponsored housing will provide opportunities for you to get involved in all aspects of the Art Institute student experience

### In addition, studies have shown that living in School Sponsored Housing:

- Impacts the development of the personal skills that are necessary for work and family relationships after school
- Increases students' support for involvement with different racial and cultural groups
- Has a strong positive impact on the development of leadership qualities
- Has strong positive effects on students' self-discovery and personal development
- Is the most important environmental characteristic associated with finishing school for those students who lived in residences during their freshman year
