

HOW TO ENTER

Applicants for the scholarship must be high school seniors graduating in 2018. Applicants must submit the following information:

- A completed entry form indicating The Art Institutes school and program of study desired. Campus locations can be found at www.artinstitutes.edu/our-campuses.
- Six slides of six different original pieces of artwork that represent your creative ability and interest. Digital files may be submitted in lieu of slides.
- A written statement describing your artistic career goals, the materials used in the pieces submitted, and how each piece was created.

Applications sent by U.S. mail must be postmarked by March 7, 2018 and applications sent by email must be sent by midnight (Eastern time), March 7, 2018. The winner will be notified after April 4, 2018.
